



**Komnino's Law-Information Sharing Form.**

On May 1, 2018 Komnino's Law went into effect in New Jersey. One aspect of the law requires community based providers to implement a policy and procedure for parents/guardians to exchange contact information with other parents/guardians within the program where services are provided.
