



Komnino's Law-Injury Notification Disclosure Request.

Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, and amending P.L.2010, c.5, mandates provision of notification to family members-and guardians where applicable of individuals served whenever a major, minor, or moderate injury occurs. In ordinary circumstances, notification must occur within 2 hours; in extraordinary circumstances notification may be up to 8 hours. Please refer to the statute for more detailed information. Family members/guardians must be provided with the option to determine whether or not they wish to be notified of an injury.

SELF-GUARDIANS HAVE THE RIGHT TO DENY ACCESS TO INJURY INFORMATION TO FAMILY MEMBER(S).
